

# QUICK REFERENCE GUIDE

## ASSESSMENT PROGRAMS\*

### Competency Assessment:

- Intended for physicians with sub-optimal performance and patient safety concerns resulting from a lack of skills or abilities
- Comprehensive, high-stakes evaluation of a physician's knowledge, skills and abilities that's tailored to their practice and reason for referral
- Completed in as few as 8-12 weeks, from application to final report

### Fitness for Duty Evaluation:

- Intended for physicians who have (or are suspected of having) a health problem affecting their ability to safely practice
- In-depth health evaluation of the physician's capacity to perform their job duties that's tailored to practice area (including active or requested privileges), past medical history, and sentinel event(s) that triggered the evaluation
- Completed in as few as 8-12 weeks, from application to final report

### PACE Aging Physician Assessment (PAPA):

- Intended for hospitals with late career practitioner policies that require a health assessment
- Screening of physical/mental health and cognitive function for late career physicians who have reached a certain age (e.g. 70 and older), with no known impairment or competency problems
- Completed in as few as 4 weeks, from application to final report
